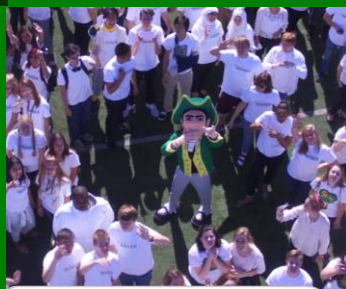

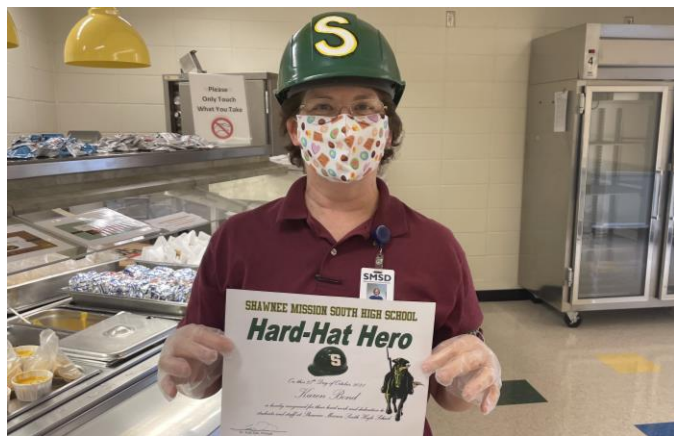

#### Mentor/Coach

**Goal:** Provide social capital to our students by matching them with an industry professional

**Time commitment:** 10 minutes/week by WebEx, email, telephone, or text

Mentors can provide career advice, review resumes, or conduct informational interviews. They can review a rough draft of a business plan, presentations, or other projects.

#### Workplace Tour/Job Shadowing

**Goal:** An opportunity to expose students to your industry

**Time commitment:** Half day

Host a team or class of students at your business for a morning or afternoon to highlight opportunities at your company and provide information on lucrative pathways. Job shadowing may involve smaller teams and show a "day in the life" of the job or industry.

**Goal:** Provide individual junior and senior students or teams of students, authentic client-projects

**Time Commitment:** 24 hours of work with at least four hours engaged with a client mentor or coach

#### Client-Connected Project Examples

### Observer Access

As we move into a new quarter, you may find that you want more access to your student's Canvas. With parent/guardian access in Canvas, you act as an Observer. As an observer, you can:

- View student grades
- View the calendar
- View a list of assignments with due dates
- Read announcements
- Receive email or text notifications for announcements, assignments, and more

## Create the Account



When creating an account, you will need to have your child's "pairing" code.

1. Gather your student(s) "pair code" from Canvas. Please make sure to follow this guide with your student to generate that code.
  - a. Your child's teacher can generate the code and provide it to you.
  - b. Your child can log into his/her account and retrieve the pairing code.
2. Open the SMSD Canvas website:  
<https://smsd.instructure.com/login/canvas>
3. Click on the Parent of a Canvas User? Click Here For an Account link.
4. Enter your name, email address, and password. Enter your Student Pairing Code.

## How to Create a Pair Code

You will want to sit side-by-side with your student to create this code and link to their Canvas account. Here is how to create the "pair code:"

1. In Global Navigation, click on the Account link, then click the Settings link.
2. Click the Pair with Observer button.
  - a. If the Pair with Observer button doesn't display in your User Settings, please contact your teacher for help.
3. Copy the six-digit alphanumeric pairing code. You will need to share the code with the observer who will link to your account. The pairing code will expire after seven days or its first use.

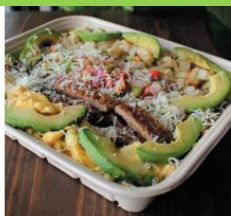
