The Advanced Placement ordering and payment websites went live this week. Tests must be ordered through the **College Board** website AND **Total Registration**. It is NOT a requirement of the class to take the test in May. Students have already registered themselves in the College Board site with their teachers in class. This site has been designed to allow teachers to give supplemental materials to students that will help them prepare for the exam. It is also the ordering site of the College Board.

This site has been set to default to 'undecided' and must be changed to 'take' or 'not take' the exam by **November 11**. Students will need to access their account and manually change this, regardless of their decision to test.

If the student decides to test, they must access the **Total Registration** website <a href="www.totalregistration.net/AP/172772">www.totalregistration.net/AP/172772</a> and complete their demographic information AND pay for the exams- also by <a href="November 11">November 11</a>.

# KANSAS ACT – February 25<sup>th</sup>, 2020

# \*Free for all juniors! Register by <u>November 8<sup>th</sup></u> in Skyward student portal!

Beginning with the 2018-2019 school year, the Kansas Legislature has appropriated funds for a statewide contract to provide one free ACT assessment and one free WorkKeys suite of assessments to qualifying students. The ACT and WorkKeys assessments are available to any high school junior enrolled in a Shawnee Mission high school. Students may participate in one or both assessments.



#### ACT

This opportunity is only available on Tuesday, February 25, 2020.

#### About the ACT

The ACT contains four multiple-choice tests—English, mathematics, reading, and science. There will NOT be an optional writing section offered on this date.

The ACT is designed to measure skills that are most important for success in postsecondary education and that are acquired in secondary education. The score range for each of the four multiple-choice tests is 1–36. A composite score is determined by the average of the four subject scores.

All colleges and universities in the United States accept ACT scores. Students will be able to report their Kansas-sponsored ACT scores to colleges just like any other ACT test administrations.

#### **ACT WorkKeys**

This opportunity is only available on Wednesday, February 26, 2020

#### About WorkKeys

The WorkKeys assessments measure foundational skills required for success in the workplace. Individuals who successfully complete all three WorkKeys assessments—Applied Math, Graphic Literacy, and Workplace Documents—can earn a WorkKeys National Career Readiness Certificate® (WorkKeysNCRC®) and/or a Kansas WORKReadyl Certificate. These certifications are a valuable credential for students and job seekers seeking to verify foundational workplace skills.

Many employers use the Kansas WORKReady! Certificate as a means for identifying quality applicants. Job seekers can present this certificate to potential employers as documentation of work skill levels.

- Students may request to have their scores sent to colleges.
- For the ACT, students will receive one paper copy score report, mailed to their home address three to eight weeks after testing. Students will also have access to an online account to view their results at <a href="www.actstudent.org">www.actstudent.org</a>.
- For WorkKeys, students will be able to view their scores on the MyWorkKeys webpage (<u>www.myworkkeys.com</u>).

#### How to sign up:

### Juniors will be able to sign up through a custom form in the Skyward student portal.

The form will become available on Monday, October 21. Signup will close on Friday, November 8. Sign up for ACT and/or WorkKeys assessments in Skyward.




