AP REMINDERS!!!

1. Please make sure to confirm your email address. If you've not received and confirmed your email address, please sign into your account and do that. myap.collegeboard.org. It's critical that the CB has the correct info to which they'll send your logon information for test day. The email they sent should have come on or about 4/13. If you didn't receive one, please log on and work through the steps to make that



- happen. If you've not been able to confirm, you can do so through 'Account Settings' in that link.
- 2. All students should plan to test on the first exam date, and on that date, should login about 30 minutes prior to the start of the exam. That way, you can work through any connectivity issues and respond to their identification questions without sacrificing any testing time. https://apcentral.collegeboard.org/courses/exam-dates-and-fees
- 3. If there are connectivity issues, you will be able to complete an incident report to swiftly report those issues to the CB. The website for CB connectivity issues is www.cb.org/apexamsecurity2020. Worst case scenario? You could go with your laptops and sit in the parking lot of the nearest SMSD school and take the exam there. I know it's not ideal, but you'll know you can connect . . .
- 4. If you absolutely cannot test according to the original dates OR you have connectivity issues on the original date, you can participate on the make up date. I would STRONGLY encourage you to try to test on the first date to leave the make up date as a back up. If you don't test on the first date, you'll be sent the credentials to take the second exam automatically.
- 5. Ignoring those emails and not testing on either of those dates cancels your test. If you know that you won't be testing, please go in through your Total Registration account and initiate a cancellation. That will initiate the process. We're strongly encouraging everyone to test, though! You've worked hard and should receive your credit!
- 6. All students should go into the system and make sure that the following things are correct: SMS School Code is listed as 172772, a correct and monitored email address is being used, and that you've indicated where you'd like scores sent. The deadline to change the destination for your score is 6/20, but the other things should be done prior to the test.
- 7. Please also go in and review the exam security policies. They are VERY strict this year. https://apcoronavirusupdates.collegeboard.org/educators/taking-the-exams/security. The CB is putting measures in place to make sure you aren't using the same routers, etc. They're also using sophisticated software to flag plagiarism. Additionally, the consequences are steep, ie. notifying colleges of academic dishonesty.
- 8. Students who are testing with accommodations are supposed to be flagged through the CB system to 'automatically' receive their accommodations. I will also email students who are to receive accommodations with their SSD information, which includes their number. Hopefully, everything will happen as the CB says. https://apcoronavirusupdates.collegeboard.org/coordinators/accommodations






