


This school year (2019-2020) the Shawnee Mission School District is utilizing the Panorama Social-Emotional Learning survey to assess student's perseverance, grit, determination, school culture and student-teacher relationships. The Panorama Social-Emotional survey takes approximately 30 to 45 minutes to complete and will be administered once each semester.

- Parents must opt their student(s) in by signing into Skyward and completing a consent form (instructions attached).
- Please log in to Skyward and complete the parent consent form by or before March 6, 2020. For more information about Panorama in SMSD, please contact your student's school and/or follow this link: SMSD Panorama Q & A.

Survey data will be reviewed at the district and classroom level to determine areas of strength, as well as areas where more instruction and/or support is needed. Once survey results are returned, parents/guardians are welcome to see and discuss the results with their students' teachers, social workers, and counselors. 
Updates From the Health Office March 2020


