The Shawnee Mission South Foundation has entered into a written agreement with SMEF to administer donated funds. The governing board of the SMS Foundation is responsible for recommending disbursements of funds from the SMS Foundation. All donated funds shall be made payable to the Shawnee Mission South Foundation and will be directly deposited to the SMEF bank account. Fund-raising expenses will be paid from the funds in the SMS Foundation Fund.




