- Check your picture. Around the beginning of January, portrait pictures with names are posted

## **REGISTRATION DAY**

## **Tuesday, July 31st** 8:00am - 7:00pm

All students must attend! Even if you have pre-paid you must attend the fee payment session for ID photo, yearbook photo, Macbook distribution, and schedule pick-up.

GET YOUR NEW MACBOOK - Macbook distribution will take place on July 31st as well. <u>BOTH Students and parents</u> must complete the on-line verification in Skyward BEFORE they can get their new Macbook. On-line Verification in Skyward will open on July 16th!

Paying your fees by mail or online may expedite your time at fee payment! <u>Mail in deadline is July 27, 2018.</u> Online fee payment is available starting July 20.

\*\*Due to our fee payment system, online fee payments must be entered by 11:00p.m. on the day prior to fee payment! Your payment WILL NOT be posted on the same day. It must process overnight.\*\*

You may place money on your student's lunch account at the time you pay your fees either by internet, mail in or at fee payment. **Fines must be resolved or included in your fee payment.** 

Those taking advantage of mail-in or internet fee payment will report directly to the <u>Express line</u> at fee payment. Those who have not pre-paid will report to the fee payment line at fee payment.

Course Fees: If your student is enrolled in a class/classes that involve an additional fee, we encourage you to include payment of fees with your regular fee payment. As part of the English curriculum, all students will be required to purchase an \$8 paperback novel to make notes in. It is a valuable tool to teach students how to get the most from their Language Arts experience.

KANCARE-MP TITLE 19 (TITLE XIX MEDICAID APPROVAL): IF YOUR STUDENT RECEIVES KANCARE/TITLE 19 BENEFITS, HIS/HER BOOK RENTAL AND ID CARD FEES WILL BE WAIVED. YOU MUST PROVIDE A COPY OF THE KANCARE CARD IN ORDER FOR FEES TO BE WAIVED.

Payment arrangements for REQUIRED fees can be made PRIOR to July 27 by e-mailing Sharon Anderson, bookkeeper, at soanders@smsd.org or in person BY APPOINTMENT ONLY. \*\* The Bookkeeper is unavailable during fee payment.

Schedule changes must be complete by August 3rd!

## **Explanation of Fees:**

All fees are optional with the exception of Book Rental, ID Card and Participation fee. Required fees must be paid in full before any optional fees can be purchased.

### **Required Fees:**

Book Rental - \$80.00 (Required of all students) Student ID - \$5.00 (Required of all students)

\*Pictures taken during fee payment session

Participation Fee – \$75.00 (Required of all students)

\*Provides partial funding for programs offered by the district.

## Optional Fees: All of these fees can be paid at a later date.

**Yearbook** - \$55.00 A 350+ page book documenting events throughout the year. You may purchase yearbooks through the bookkeeper until Dec. 7. A very limited number of books will be available at yearbook distribution for \$65.

Class Dues - \$5.00 Finances class projects & activities.

**Parking Permits** - \$60.00. Bring driver's license and the vehicle license tag number.

**StuCo** - \$5.00 Assists with activities that the student body participates in during the year including canned food drive, dances, conferences, etc. **Pep Club** – \$10.00 Provides for the general operation of Pep Club which is involved in spirit and support for all SM South activities. Members receive a t-shirt and are admitted to pep assemblies.

Fines - If fees for lost books/fines have not been paid prior to fee payment, please include this amount with student's fees, or send a separate check prior to fee payment. A hold slip is enclosed indicating amount owed for lost books/fines. Unpaid course fees remain on your student's account. Overpayments will be transferred to your student's lunch account, unless a refund is requested.

**Senior Open Lunch** Permission forms are available in the office for parent signature. We must have a signed form on file prior to August 3 for seniors to be allowed to leave campus for lunch. (Office hours are 7 a.m. – 3:30 p.m. Mon. - Fri. The office is closed June 20 - July 23, 2018.)

Freshman Classes Begin August 10, 2018 at 7:40 a.m. All other grade levels begin on August 13, 2018 at 7:40 a.m.

### Shawnee Mission South Foundation Operational Summary

The Shawnee Mission South Foundation is a not-for-profit Kansas corporation that manages a donor fund which has been established with the Shawnee Mission Education Foundation (SMEF). The SMEF was established by the Shawnee Mission School District in 1989 to "provide all Shawnee Mission School District students innovative opportunities to help them reach their full potential and become productive, valued members of the community." The SMEF is a recognized § 501 (c)(3) tax-exempt organization. All donations made to it are tax-deductible. The Shawnee Mission South Foundation has entered into a written agreement with SMEF to administer donated funds. The governing board of the SMS Foundation is responsible for recommending disbursements of funds from the SMS Foundation. All donated funds shall be made payable to the Shawnee Mission South Foundation and will be directly deposited to the SMEF bank account. Fund-raising expenses will be paid from the funds in the SMS Foundation Fund.
