

- **Friday, March 19 – No school, professional learning**
- **Wednesday, May 26 – Last day for Pre-K**
- **Graduation: Monday, May 24: SM South @ South Stadium 8:00 PM**
- **Thursday, May 27 – Last day for grades K-11 (early release)**
- **Friday, May 28 – Teacher Workday/Last day for staff**

# SNOW DAY?


## ► SNOW DAY UPDATE REMINDER ◀


