



PSAT/NMSOT

The Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test (PSAT/NMSQT) is a <u>standardized</u> test administered by the <u>College Board</u>.

- All <u>FRESHMAN</u> will take the Pre-ACT and will NOT need to register or pay for the test.
- All <u>SOPHOMORES</u> will take the PSAT at Shawnee Mission South on October 16. Sophomores will NOT need to register or pay for the test.
- For <u>JUNIORS</u>, the scores from the PSAT/NMSQT are used to determine eligibility and qualification for the National Merit Scholarship Program and, thus, must be enrolled independent of the schools. All juniors wishing to take the PSAT for NMSQT qualification will need to register and pay \$20 for the exam by <u>Monday</u>, <u>October 14th!</u> Online registration: <u>https://user.totalregistration.net/PSAT/172772</u>
- Juniors who do not take the PSAT will take the Practice ACT and will NOT need to register or pay for the test.
- <u>SENIORS</u> have the option for community service, job shadow, college workshop, or college visit. Parents need to complete the <u>Senior Exploration Day Form HERE</u>.


