SMSD Calendar Updates!

On Monday, January 25, the Shawnee Mission Board of Education approved a revised calendar for the remainder of the 2020-2021 school year. A copy of the calendar may be found on the district's <u>website</u>. Barring unforeseen circumstances that would prevent SMSD from holding classes, here is a brief summary of the changes in the new calendar:

- Friday, March 19 No school, professional learning
- Wednesday, May 26 Last day for Pre-K
- Graduation: Monday, May 24: SM South @ South Stadium 8:00 PM
- Thursday, May 27 Last day for grades K-11 (early release)
- Friday, May 28 Teacher Workday/Last day for staff

Based on the revised state guidelines, **the last day of class for seniors** will be Wednesday, May 19.

Student Camera Expectations

Beginning the second semester, SM South will expect students to have their computer cameras turned on when the teacher requests that they do so on remotelearning days.

This means the camera is on and the teacher should see smiling student faces ©!

(no, you can't get out of this by pointing the camera at the ceiling).

This will allow for a more engaging and effective remote learning environment. The benefits of having cameras turned on during instruction include:

- Camera use increases the connection between the teacher and the student;
- \circ $\ \ \,$ Teachers are more able to identify and call students by name;
- Teachers are more able to to check to see if students are engaged, to provide feedback for learning, and to check for confusion.

Are You Set Up As An Observer In Canvas?

- Parents/Guardians can access observer accounts to view grades, resources, and activities posted in their child's course. There are two ways to access and interact with Canvas as a parent: 1) using the Canvas <u>website</u> from a computer or phone and 2) using the Canvas Parent App. (<u>iOS</u>, <u>Android</u>)
- #1 Create the account When creating an account, you will need to have your child's "pairing" code. Your child can log into his/her account and retrieve the pairing code. An observer account can be created within the app for mobile devices (<u>iOS</u>, <u>Android</u>) or via the URL <u>https://smsd.instructure.com/login/canvas</u> <u>PDF Screenshots</u>
- **# 2 Logging In** When visiting the URL, <u>https://smsd.instructure.com/login/canvas</u>, you will be asked to find your school. Begin typing Shawnee Mission and select parent/guardian. At the login page, select "parent of a canvas user-create account."

Tips for Managing Multiple Children in Canvas

Course Nicknames

- You may adjust the nickname for each course. That way, you can include each child's first initial or name ahead of the course name (ie: "K: US History" or "Kelly: US History").
- Course nicknames appear in the Dashboard, course navigation menu, course breadcrumbs, and notification emails. The nicknames will also appear on the Canvas app.
- The course nickname is only available to the individual user who created the nicknames.
- To access the nickname field, click the three dots in the top right hand corner of the course card.

Course Colors

- Another option is to color code the course cards so all of child #1's courses are one color, all of child #2's courses are a second, etc.
- The color that is shown on the course card is synced with the color shown for the course in the Calendar.
- The course card colors are only available to the individual user who selected the colors.
- To select course card colors, click the three dots in the top right hand corner of the course card.

Canvas Parent App

• While viewing Canvas from a web browser as an Observer gives you very detailed information about the course, the Canvas Parent App allows the Observer to view a student's course events (calendar) and upcoming assignments, and course announcements.

The Parent App allows the Observer to view one student's course information at a time.
