President's Volunteer Service Award Program at SMS

The President's Volunteer Service Award (PVSA) is a national program that recognizes and honors students who demonstrate outstanding service to their community, nation, or abroad. Volunteer service hours should be tracked during the twelve month period between **April 1, 2020 and March 31, 2021.**

For students age 16 or older the awards are as follows:

GOLD: 250 or more hours of service

SILVER: 175-249 hours of service

BRONZE: 100-174 hours of service

For students who are 15 by April 1, 2019, the awards are as follows:

GOLD: 100 or more hours of service

SILVER: 75-99 hours of service

BRONZE: 50-74 hours of service



A variety of volunteer services qualify. Fundraising for community services and faith-based service can be included. Activities must be unpaid. Travel time and actual work time on volunteer trips may be counted. NHS hours can also count toward PVSA hours. The following do not qualify for volunteer service hours:

- Fund-raising for sports teams, choir, plays, etc. from which the student benefits.
- Family obligations.
- Court-ordered community service
- Activities required for class projects/programs
- Sleeping or entertainment time after you traveled to the volunteer location.

All service hours must be verified. Volunteers should provide a complete list of service by filling out both the tracking form and the documentation form. Documentation forms must be signed by the contact person that sponsored the service activity. **Return completed forms to the SMS main office by April 16, 2021.** Questions: Please contact: Dara Giuliani - daragiuliani@gmail.com

Panorama Information for Parents/Guardians:

This school year (2020-2021) the Shawnee Mission School District is once again utilizing the Panorama Social-Emotional Learning survey to assess student's perseverance, grit, determination, school culture and student-teacher relationships. The Panorama Social-Emotional survey takes approximately 30 to 45 minutes to complete and will be administered once each semester.

The second survey window is scheduled for April 12-April 19, 2021. The Panorama Survey can be completed by students in the remote or in-building learning environment. Parents/Guardians would have opted their student(s) in or out of the survey during the 20-21 registration process. Survey data will be reviewed at the district and classroom level to determine areas of strength, as well as areas where more instruction and/or support is needed. **Once survey results are returned, parents/guardians are welcome to request, see and discuss the results with their students' teachers, social workers, and counselors.** Sample survey questions can be found [here](#) and [here](#).

Dear South Family & Friends –

We hope you're staying warm! It's so nice to feel that Spring is just around the corner. Before you know it, this pandemic school year will be drawing to a close. Spring semester and graduation are always a little bittersweet for Seniors, but this year will be particularly tough. We want the memories of graduation night to be really special, positive and safe for this year's class.

2021 will mark the 30th year that SMS will host Project Graduation following our graduation ceremony. The event provides a venue for creating positive and safe memories on this special evening. Project Graduation is promoted by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration and endorsed by the SMS PTSA and the Shawnee Mission administration. And, every graduating student is invited to attend this fun, safe and substance free event.

Project Graduation generally costs about \$28,000 and relies on support from the entire school. We're asking each SMS family to help offset this cost by making a financial donation if they're able.
