# 2021-2022 QUICK STEP PLUS COLLEGE ALGEBRA ENROLLMENT GUIDE FOR HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS

OSPCA is an independent study self-paced course, not a College Now course. Your college credit is determined by assessment of the course material by a JCCC professor. To earn college credit, complete the steps below.

- **1. APPLY** for admission only one time regardless of how many semesters you take classes at JCCC. Go to **admissions.jccc.edu** to start your application. For new students, to ensure your eligibility to enroll before the deadline, apply no later than the priority date listed on the calendar on the next page. When your application is processed, you will receive an email that includes your JCCC ID number and login information.
- 2. TEST or place into your College Algebra course. If you have an ACT Math score of 22 or higher you may request a placement waiver by going to jccc.edu/QuickStepPlus. Click the Request a Placement Waiver button to submit your ACT scores. If you do not have a qualifying ACT Math score, go to jccc.edu/placement to schedule an appointment to take the Accuplacer placement test at JCCC. The deadline to complete the Accuplacer placement testing is October 8. The deadline to submit your ACT scores and request a placement waiver is October 1. You will still need to enroll in the class after your placement waiver is issued or after you test and earn a qualifying score.
- **3. ENROLL** in classes online, by phone, or in person. For enrollment DEADLINE DATES, see calendar on the next page.
  - To enroll online, first you will need the appropriate five-digit CRN that can be found in the table.
  - Log in to MyJCCC and click the green Add/Drop Classes button. Select the term "Credit Fall" for fall semester/ yearlong courses.
  - Select the Enter CRNs tab on the top left, enter the five-digit CRN number for your course, click Add, then click Agree & Submit.
  - Confirm that your courses show a status of "Registered" to ensure your enrollment was successful.
- **4. PAY** tuition at the time of enrollment. Tuition may be paid online by logging in to MyJCCC and selecting the My Finances tab. No payments can be accepted by phone. Students are financially responsible for all charges on their account.

#### October 2021

- 1 ACT test score and placement waiver request deadline
- 8 Deadline to complete Accuplacer placement test
- 8 Last day to enroll in a Quick Step Plus College Algebra course
- 25 Last day to drop with 100% refund

#### November 2021

8 Last day to drop without a "W" on transcript

#### March 2022

1 Last day to withdraw with a "W" on transcript or request pass/fail grade option
