

The Movement & Learning Connection

In general, people learn better when information is presented in more than one way (Sankey, Birch, & Gardiner, 2010). Movement and learning have been largely connected in studies. Movement while learning enhances cognitive focus and increases brain cells.

Specifically, the use of gestures results in more enduring learning than learning without gestures (Cook, Yip, & Goldin-Meadow, S, 2010). Learning walks is another method teachers use to support students in processing new information. Movement enhanced learning has been proven to support reading and verbal fluency skills. Study after study shows that physical activity activates the brain, improves cognitive function, and is correlated with improved academic performance (Donnelly & Lambourne, 2011). This means any kind of physical activity, not just movement associated with the material we're learning, can benefit students academically. Teachers have now implemented more processing breaks and other opportunities for student movement during their classes.

The Kansas Department of Health and Environment has issued new vaccination requirements for the 2019-2020 school year. The new requirements affect Kindergarten, 1st grade, 7th grade, and 11th grade students:

Hepatitis A: Kindergarten and first grade students must have one dose to attend school. Second dose must be given 6 months after initial dose.

Meningococcal (Serogroup A,C,W,Y): 7th and 11th grade students must have one dose to attend school. 7th grade students will receive a second dose in 11th grade. For 11th grade students, only one dose is required.

Shawnee Mission South President's Volunteer Service Award Program

The President's Volunteer Service Award (PVSA) is a national program that recognizes and honors students who demonstrate outstanding service to their community, nation, or abroad. Volunteer service hours should be tracked during the twelve month period between

April 1, 2018 and March 31, 2019.

For students age 16 or older the awards are as follows:

GOLD: 250 or more hours of service SILVER: 175-249 hours of service BRONZE: 100-174 hours of service

For students who are 15 by April 1, 2019, the awards are as follows:

GOLD: 100 or more hours of service SILVER: 75-99 hours of service BRONZE: 50-74 hours of service



A variety of volunteer services qualify. Fundraising for community services and faith-based service can be included. Activities must be unpaid. Travel time and actual work time on volunteer trips may be counted. NHS hours can also count toward PVSA hours. The following do not quality for volunteer service hours:

Fund-raising for sports teams, choir, plays, etc. from which the student benefits.

Family obligations.

Court-ordered community service

Activities required for class projects/programs

Sleeping or entertainment time after you traveled to the volunteer location.
