ACCUPLACER Placement Test – College Now Information

Due to the ever evolving nature of Covid-19 protocols, it is important to check <u>https://www.jccc.edu/media-resources/covid-19/</u> for updated information regarding JCCC's social distancing and facial covering requirements. Prior to coming on campus, you are expected to complete the Covid-19 wellness self-check which can be found on that website.

The ACCUPLACER placement test is required if you do not meet the prerequisite requirements (qualifying ACT or AP score(s), unweighted high school GPA) for the course(s) in which you wish to enroll.

1. HOW CAN I SIGN UP FOR THE ACCUPLACER PLACEMENT TEST?

- Tests are scheduled by appointment only for specific 1.5 and 2-hour time slots during Testing Services' open hours. Appointments must be scheduled *at least* 48 hours in advance of your desired testing date. It is recommended that you do not wait to schedule your appointment since seating is limited and the testing demand will be high.
- Schedule an appointment using the following link, which is also located on the College Now Testing Information webpage: <u>https://www.jccc.edu/admissions/early-college/high-school- concurrent-enrollment/high-school-testing.html</u>.
- Students, you should schedule your own appointment, because you will be required to acknowledge that you have read the requirements and limitations expected in the Testing Center and agree to adhere to them. Parents, teachers, and counselors are encouraged to provide assistance if needed.
- By scheduling your appointment with Testing Services, you are confirming your commitment to fulfill this obligation. Should you need to cancel and wish to reschedule at a later date, you may find that appointments are booked solid due to a heavy demand for testing. Choosing and keeping the first available appointment is always a wise choice.
- Appointment confirmations and all other correspondence from Testing Services will be sent to your JCCC student email address.
- Early evening and Saturday testing appointments will be available.

The following items *are required* to test:

- a. A scheduled appointment
- b. Current and valid government-issued or student photo ID card
- c. JCCC 8-digit student ID number memorized or written down

2. HOW CAN I PREPARE FOR THE ACCUPLACER PLACEMENT TEST?

For you to do your very best, it is important that you review before taking the placement test(s). By reviewing, you will have the opportunity to sharpen your skills and become familiar with the test-taking experience. The number of test questions you may receive on the math test will range from 20 to 50, depending on your skill level. You can find Accuplacer study materials at:

3. CAN I BRING ANYTHING (OR ANYONE) WITH ME TO THE TESTING CENTER?

Only you will be allowed during processing and in the Testing Center. We ask that others refrain from accompanying you to Testing Services.

The following items *are allowed* during your test session:

- a. Writing utensil (Testing Services will provide disposable golf pencils for your use.)
- b. Car keys (must be small enough to fit into your pocket)
 - *i*. If you are dropped off to test, make sure to leave your cell phone/all other personal items either at home or with your driver. Once you have finished testing, our staff will call your driver.
- c. If you bring any unallowed items with you outside of the above listed items, you will be asked to
 - *i.* store the item(s) in your car, or
 - *ii.* call someone to come and retrieve the item(s), or
 - *iii.* reschedule your test session for another day.

The following items are *absolutely prohibited* in the Testing Center. Prohibited items include, but are not limited to:

- Cell phone(s)
- Watches of any kind
- Activity (fitness) trackers
- Electronics any and all
- Calculators (There is one built into the test program that will be accessible only on certain questions.)
- Sunglasses
- Eyeglass/sunglass cases
- Food and drinks (including water)
- Hats, scarves, purses, bags, backpacks
- Books, notes
- Flash drives
- Cameras
- Pencil bags/boxes
