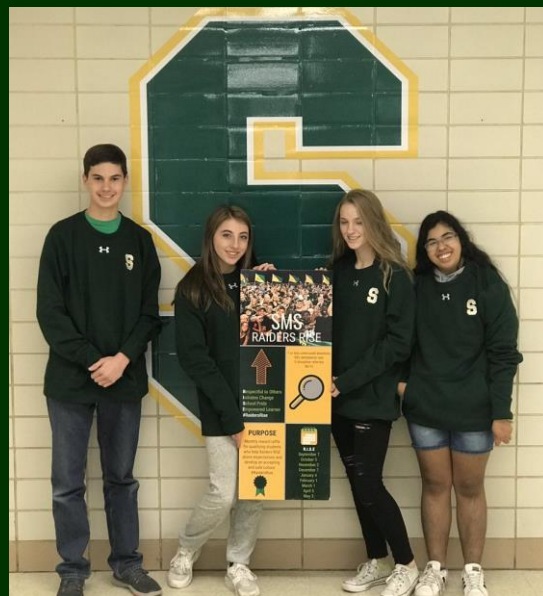

Keeping Kids Safe Online

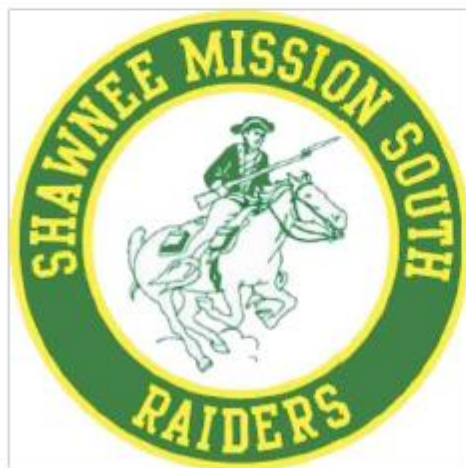


November 14, 2018 – IW Library – 6 PM
