

2020-2021 Scheduling Update



SCHEDULE INFORMATION:

- -Remote only students are those who chose remote for the entire semester. "In Person/Regular* students are those who chose to adjust to the district's criteria. (Virtual, Hybrid, or Full Time).
- -Remote only students may have teachers from across the district as classes were shared by all high schools.
- -If you are a Remote Only student you may see two teachers for the same class. This is also ok.
- -All students will start virtually. Please check your email frequently for updated information from your teachers, counselors, and/or admin.
- -Make sure you have updated your macbook to Catalina.
- -Make sure you are set up in CANVASour new learning management system.
- -Tuesday 9/8 is 9th and 12th grade only. This will be a traditional day. Students will have hours 1-7.
- -Wednesday 9/9 is for all students 9-12. This day will be hours 1-4.

WHO CAN REQUEST A SCHEDULE CHANGE?

Schedules will ONLY be adjusted for the following reasons:

- · Seniors who are missing a graduation requirement.
- Students who have an incomplete schedule. All students should have 7 blocks and a seminar (seminars will be added by 9/8).
- · Students missing a core course.
- If a student sees "Email Counselor" on their schedule please do so as soon as possible to resolve a conflict.
- Students who have already passed a class that cannot be repeated for credit.
- Students who have failed a prerequisite course and need to be removed from the advanced class.
- "In Person" students who have accidentally been enrolled in a Remote section. Your room number will say REM if this is the case.

Email your counselor ONLY if one of these reasons apply to you.





Pandemic EBT

While schools are closed due to COVID-19, families with children age 5-18 who received free or reduced-priced meals from August 2019-May 2020 will receive up to \$291 per child in Pandemic EBT (P-EBT) benefits to purchase food. This benefit is in addition to any other services families are currently receiving.

How will families receive their P-FRT henefits?

Most families with eligible children recently or currently participating in Food Assistance, Child Care or TANF (cash assistance) programs will automatically receive the onetime benefit to their EBT card in the next few weeks

Families not actively participating in these programs, but whose children receive free or reduced-price meals will be mailed a Kansas Benefits Card with benefits pre-loaded in the next few weeks. If these families do not receive a Kansas Benefits card by **June** 5th, they may need to provide additional information to DCF. These families should watch for a confidential weblink provided by their school district.

Use it like a debit card.

Families will receive the P-EBT benefit on a Kansas Benefits Card. This card functions like a debit card and can be used to purchase eligible fooditems at EBT authorized retailers. Non-food items *may not* be purchased with this card.

Kansas will continue to comply with civil rights requirements, including providing equal access to individuals with disabilities and individuals who are limited English proficient.

You also have the option to purchase your yearbook using a credit card at www.balfour.com starting September 8. Choose YEARBOOKS, search for Shawnee Mission South and follow the website prompts. There is a \$1.00 service fee if you choose to purchase through Balfour.com.

After December 11, the only way to purchase your yearbook is through Balfour.com. The cost of the yearbook goes up to \$60 starting January 1 so purchase your copy early!
