These skills are critical to school, career, life success, and one's sense of belonging. South's Counseling Department provides school-wide resources for student awareness and teacher implementation to assist in the understanding of social and emotional development. For November and December South is focusing on *Grit* and *Growth Mindset*.

- *Grit* is defined as how well students are able to persevere through setbacks to achieve important long-term goals.
- **Growth Mindset** is one's belief that their basic abilities can be developed through dedication and hard work. Consequently, a fixed mindset is one in which people believe their skills/traits are fixed.


