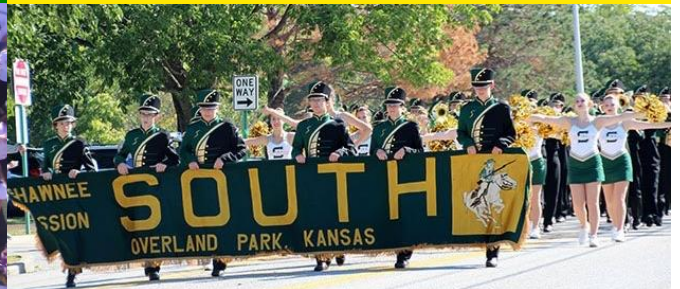

- Sophomore and Junior Practice ACT results were distributed two weeks ago during advisory. Please ask your child to see their results. PSAT and PRE-ACT (9th grade) results will be distributed next week.

Updates From the Health Office

December 2021

All things Covid

As we prepare for second semester and the likelihood of increased COVID cases after winter break, we are asking parents of students who have received the vaccine to provide documentation of their student's COVID vaccine to the school nurse. While COVID vaccine documentation is not required, it helps the school nurses in two ways:

1. Students who are asymptomatic, with documentation of being fully vaccinated, are not excluded from school if exposed to a positive case.
 2. Nurses can better estimate the number of fully vaccinated students in a building which is useful information when there are outbreaks.
- Again, while COVID vaccine documentation is not required, it would be helpful to the school nurses.

COVID-19 Vaccines

Vaccines are available to individuals age 5 and older through the Johnson County Department of Health and Environment. Appointments must be made for first, second, additional or booster COVID-19 vaccines. JCDHE is not able to accommodate walk-ins for COVID-19 vaccinations. Vaccines are also available at JCDHE's community vaccine clinics, through local health care systems and at local pharmacies. Get yours today so you can have a safe and Healthy Holiday.

TALKING TO YOUR STUDENT ABOUT

XELLO

Xello is a college and career readiness program designed to help organize student plans in one centralized location. Students complete Xello lessons during their advisory period for the purpose of equipping students with the knowledge and planning capabilities to help them navigate their future.

What Xello Provides



When students complete Xello during their advisory period, this is what the program provides:

- Assessments that build self-knowledge about their interests, skills, and strengths. Each lesson also helps students reflect on their results.
- Personalized student portfolios that are sharable and showcase their interests, skills, and abilities.
- Lessons that provide students with opportunities for exploring college and career options that align with their survey results. These lessons also provide authentic lenses into different career options with real-world interviews.
- The option for students to request e-transcripts and letters of recommendation to ease future application processes.
- The integration of Method Test Prep to help students see how their ACT and SAT results align with acceptance requirements at various post-secondary institutions.
- The ability to track the college application process with the college application tracker.
- Interactive planning tools that help create a roadmap during their high school experience.
- Integrated lessons that build essential skills and knowledge so that students are successful throughout future life stages.

1. What are some of the most exciting results you learned about from your Xello Match Maker?
2. Were you surprised by any of your results, and why?
3. What are some of the career matches that were suggested to you?
4. What are your overall thoughts about some of the career matches that were suggested to you? What are you most excited about, and why?
5. What are some of the classes that were suggested that you could take to help you work towards your future goals? What are your thoughts about these classes, and why?

Ways to Build Interest

As a parent, there is a lot you can do to help your child get excited about their future. Here are some of the ways that are suggested by Xello:

1. Talk about what your job means to you.
2. Encourage your child to reflect on their own strengths and preferences.
3. Point out careers in the community and among your friends and family.
4. Encourage your child to consider all options for their career trajectory.
5. Tour a variety of post-secondary institutions outside of 4-year universities.
6. Take time to review your child's results from Xello lessons and reflection activities.
