

Updates From the Health Office December 2021

All things Covid

As we prepare for second semester and the likelihood of increased COVID cases after winter break, we are asking parents of students who have received the vaccine to provide documentation of their student's COVID vaccine to the school nurse. While COVID vaccine documentation is not required, it helps the school nurses in two ways:

- 1. Students who are asymptomatic, with documentation of being fully vaccinated, are not excluded from school if exposed to a positive case.
- 2. Nurses can better estimate the number of fully vaccinated students in a building which is useful information when there are outbreaks. Again, while COVID vaccine documentation is not required, it would be helpful to the school nurses.

COVID-19 Vaccines

Vaccines are available to individuals age 5 and older through the Johnson County Department of Health and Environment. Appointments must be made for first, second, additional or booster COVID-19 vaccines. JCDHE is not able to accommodate walk-ins for COVID-19 vaccinations. Vaccines are



also available at <u>JCDHE's community vaccine clinics</u>, through <u>local health care</u> <u>systems</u> and at <u>local pharmacies</u>. Get yours today so you can have a safe and Healthy Holiday.








Xello is a college and career readiness program designed to help organize student plans in one centralized location. Students complete Xello lessons during their advisory period for the purpose of equipping







What XelloProvides



When students complete Xello during their advisory period, this is what the program provides:

- Assessments that build self-knowledge about their interests, skills, and strengths. Each lesson also helps students reflect on their results.
- · Personalized student portfolios that are sharable and showcase their interests, skills, and abilities.
- Lessons that provide students with opportunities for exploring college and career options that align
 with their survey results. These lessons also provide authentic lenses into different career options with
 real-world interviews.
- The option for students to request e-transcripts and letters of recommendation to ease future application processes.
- The integration of Method Test Prep to help students see how their ACT and SAT results align with acceptance requirements at various post-secondary institutions.
- The ability to track the college application process with the college application tracker.
- · Interactive planning tools that help create a roadmap during their high school experience.
- Integrated lessons that build essential skills and knowledge so that students are successful throughout future life stages.
